## TRAVEL & ACCOMODATIONS

This year the camp will be held at a new location. Camp Talahi is a show-place of Michigan wildlife. 250 acres of natural woodland, a spring fed lake, wild flowers and wildlife surround you at every turn. Along with the natural amenities, Talahi also provides modern facilities. The main lodge has a fieldstone fireplace, screened in porch, ample seating, and a fully equipped kitchen. There are 2 dormitories that can accommodate up to 80 people. Each dorm has separate shower and restroom facilities. Talahi offers camping as well with many camp sites for pitching a tent. The beautiful waterfront provides many activities like swimming, canoeing, and other watercraft.

One of Talahi's best features is its location. Talahi seems rustic and secluded, but the campground is a quick journey from Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti, Lansing, Flint and metro Detroit.

Camping is the main accommodation so please bring your own all-weather camping gear (ie. Sleeping bag, tent, flashlight). Beds in the dormitories are available at an additional cost of \$20 a day. Three meals are provided daily featuring traditional African/Congolese cuisine and vegetarian options. Hot water and bathing facilities are provided.
